Two consecutive reports below RED are required. Algae is currently only effecting some areas of the dam with much of the water clear for all water sports and the fish still biting.

There's also plenty of other ways to enjoy the park, with such attractions as Jumping Pillow the Water Park perfect for kids of all ages to cool off on sizzling Summer days.

With some accommodation still available , Copeton Waters Park Manager David Allan said he was looking forward to greeting all our guests this holiday season.

"There are plenty of areas of the dam for our guests and day visitors to use for swimming & skiing this Christmas," David said.

"Go fishing, tee up at the park golf course or pack the binoculars for a spot of bird watching. If you're feeling adventurous, Copeton Waters is the perfect gateway to the wider area, with an array of national parks to explore and the historic town of Inverell just a short drive away.

"We are receiving regular updates from *WaterNSW* in relation to the algae and expect it continue to reduce."
