Fuel Tank Closures Across Our Inland Holiday Parks

UPDATE: temporary and safe fuel supply solution information

As communicated previously, we have been looking at a controlled and manageable way for guests to bring and store fuel in to the parks for their use within the next few weeks.

This temporary and safe fuel supply solution involves us purchasing Dangerous Goods compliant shipping containers, for the affected parks, which will be utilised as secure fuel storage facilities. They are ventilated and self-bunded to contain spills. The containers will be located on a flat surface within each park, with a marked decanting area adjacent to the containers which will be monitored and controlled by authorised staff.

Our staff will be inducted and trained on the correct safety procedures to operate and manage this area for guests and visitors and it will be equipped with fire extinguishers, spill kits and other relevant safety items.

Staff will play a role in the retrieval of guests' fuel from the locked container, decanting the fuel on their behalf whilst following our strict safety procedures.

Further information on this system and procedure will be communicated to our guests and throughout local communities within the next few weeks.

Again, we have worked closely with our fuel consultants to put this interim measure in place. Thank you for your patience and understanding.
