## Management of Reflections Killalea Reserve

The Trust took over management of Killalea Reserve (now Reflections Killalea Reserve) on 28 October 2016, in line with taking over nine inland holiday parks.

With the assistance of Public Reserve Management Funding and the Trust's own funds, we have implemented over \$20 million in improvements to these previous (nine) state parks.

One of the significant benefits that Reflections has, is that any surplus funds generated are used to both redevelop the parks, and to fund the significant open space for the benefit of people NSW. These funds and investments come from running the commercial activities within our holiday parks.

The local community have appreciated the Trust's commitment to enhance the facilities at *Reflections Killalea Reserve*. Reflections' charter is to contribute to the Triple Bottom Line balancing the environment, social and economic outcomes.

Killalea Reserve is a valued community asset and current management under *Reflections Holiday Parks* continues to see this Reserve managed in <u>a respectful and professional way</u> that enables communities to continue to enjoy this precious space.

We enable the successful running of community events such as *Sculptures at Killalea* and the Farm's Markets.

To date, there has been no consultation or communication with the Reserve's Trust or with management regarding change of management at Killalea Reserve.
