

New Amenities for Brunswick Heads' Foreshore

The Brunswick Foreshore Reserves will be getting a much-needed facelift with construction underway for the upgrade and refurbishment of amenities across Terrace Reserve, Banner Park and Torakina Reserve.

Reflections Holiday Parks CEO Steve Edmonds said Reflections was pleased to have secured \$1,227,000 in funding from the NSW Government to provide better amenities for the residents and visitors to the area.

"We have awarded Stage One of this important project to AGS Commercial," Mr Edmonds said.

"Brunswick Heads is a regional gem of NSW and we are committed to upgrading the amenities across the three reserves to a standard that can better serve the local community and visitors to this much-loved part of NSW."

The amenity upgrades across the three reserves, which are expected to be completed progressively over the coming months, include new fixtures, fittings, tiles and painting as well as the inclusion of accessible toilets and showers.

Mr Edmonds said the response towards the amenity upgrades and other planned works has been very positive.

"Following feedback from Byron Shire Council, a design for the Torakina Reserve amenities recommended by the Brunswick Chamber of Commerce was adopted," Mr Edmonds said.

"The amenities are in poor condition and the reserves really need some love. Now, thanks to Restart NSW funding through the *Regional Growth – Environment and Tourism Fund*, we have the means to be able to improve the experience for everyone when they visit with their families."


About Reflections Holiday Parks

Brunswick Foreshore Reserves

The three Brunswick foreshore reserves provide for a range of functions and activities including active and passive recreational pursuits, community events, spaces for social interaction, access to the foreshore and protection and preservation of environmental and cultural resources.

Reflections Holiday Parks have secured funding from the NSW State Government for the refurbishment of public amenities, carrying out repairs to the Simpson Creek revetment wall, and other landscaping activities.

The objective of this project is to arrest the environmental degradation of the reserves while improving facilities, amenities and playgrounds.



Stage One of the project will progressively upgrade and refurbish the public amenities at Torakina Reserve, Banner Park and Terrace Park; each building will briefly be unavailable while these works are being carried out each having roughly a six week construction period.

The Torakina floor plan (below left) follows on from the recent designs and funding applications prepared by the Chamber of Commerce, we're excited to see these works come to fruition.
