

## **Moonee Beach Doggy Date Night – Poodles of Fun!**

"It was great to see families spread out on the grass with picnics and their pups to enjoy our outdoor screening of *A Dog's Purpose* and connect together through food, pet portraits, essential oils for dogs and a walk along our spectacular headland."

"We pride ourselves on our great facilities for those guests who are travelling with their dogs, so this fundraising event is a good fit for us. We have a pet-friendly park and two dogs of our own, so we appreciate the good work that RSPCA NSW does and the value they bring to the local animal community in need."

RSPCA NSW Senior Manager Eliza Walker said the Moonee Beach Reflections' park was a dog's paradise with plenty of open space, picturesque views and a magical walk through lantern-like fireflies as part of the evening.

"Like last year, Park Managers Mark and Kelly Shaw went the extra mile to support the night and ensure the event was a success," Ms Walker said.
