

Lockdown Lifted: Book a Reflections Spring Getaway on the South Coast for a Whale of a Time!

"We have made 25 bookings so far since the announcement yesterday to 2:30pm today and the phones are still running hot," Mr Donohue said.

"Bermagui is a perfect whale watching spot. I saw six or seven giants this morning just outside the park on the headland having an absolute ripper of a time in the water. What better way to enjoy your morning cuppa than with a whale watching sea show?"

"Seven of our cabins also have direct ocean views so there is no more perfect place on earth than right here, right now! And don't forget to bring your pups with you - we have two pet friendly cabins and ensuite sites as well for a more luxurious feel."

Reflections Park Manager at Eden and Pambula Robyn Kidd said the lockdown lift was a real mood booster for the parks, guests, and local communities.

"There is real excitement in the air and people are walking around with broad smiles on their faces," Mrs Kidd said. At Eden we saw 13 bookings made pretty soon after yesterday's announcement and the queries keep coming in. And right now the whales are booming – the local Whale Festival may have been cancelled but you can still see them from our park."

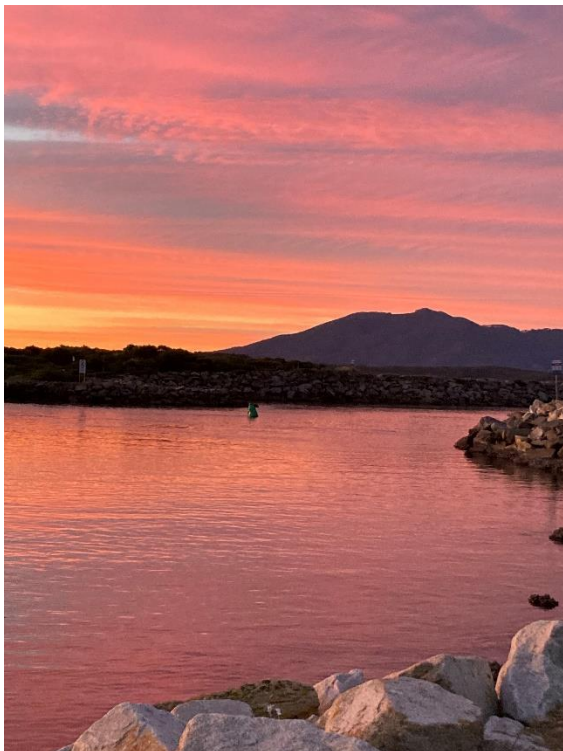
