

It's a Water and Wildlife Bonanza at Lake Keepit Celebrating Guests Returning with Discounted Holidays

In celebration of NSW opening up and to welcome back guests with a bang, the Reflections Holiday Park at Lake Keepit is providing discounted holidays until 9 December 2021 with 20 per cent off bookings across all powered and unpowered sites.

Reflections Lake Keepit Manager Leith Smith said now was a perfect time to get out to Lake Keepit, especially with the dam hovering around the 100 per cent mark and the wildlife more abundant than ever.

"The dam is thriving here at the moment," Mr Smith said. "Bush campers and unpowered site users on the dam's edge are mooring their boats right in front of their camp sites. They say that conditions couldn't be more perfect for boating and water sports."

"The water is at optimum levels and looks like a sheet of glass which is so good for dam use. Our slide pontoon is also ready and raring to go with the great water conditions."

The high dam levels have attracted an abundance of birds and wildlife back to the reserve with Leith reporting around 20 swan families with babies delighting guests. "We have also seen the return of our wedge tailed eagles who are just everywhere at the moment and white-breasted sea eagles are flocking around the dam inlets," he said.

For stays of two nights or more, until 9 December 2021, the 37 Reflections Holiday Parks, including Lake Keepit will offer 20 per cent off all powered and unpowered sites offer is available for a limited time only.

Mr Smith said the park's resident white kangaroo, 'Wally' was also being seen more and more around the reception area. "Only one in 50-000-100,000 kangaroos are albino or white so it is an absolute privilege for our guests to be able to see him here. This does of course lead to a 'Where's Wally?' joke but I'll settle for ending with, 'Wallabies may play rugby, but our Lake Keepit kangaroos are all about League."

The Lake Keepit Kiosk is currently open from Friday through to Sunday with plans to open daily once the school holidays start in mid-December. As well as hot food and refreshments, pedal carts are also available for hire through the kiosk and are a popular option for getting around the park.

Reflections Holiday Parks CEO Nick Baker said Lake Keepit was considered the local beach by many residents across the Tamworth LGA and surrounding communities.

"Like all nine of our country parks, Lake Keepit is the pride and joy of the region, showcasing the wildlife and unique bush landscape of regional NSW in a relaxed recreational setting," Mr Baker said.

"We know people are eager to get out and have some fun and we think a discounted holiday at Lake Keepit, enjoying the fresh air and one of the best locations this State has to offer, is the perfect way to boost people's spirits and boost local economies."
